HOW IS YOUR *reset?*

Earlier this year, Pastor Les stated that this is our year to Reset. He also said, “One of the greatest ways that the enemy fights us is broken focus. The reason people don’t reach goals is because the enemy puts other goals in their path; death by distraction”. However, this year, God is pressing the Reset Button in the areas of divine purpose, family and relationships, health and finances.

The first question to ask is what does it mean to reset? It means to refocus, realign, recalibrate, redo, recommit, and replant. The word recalibrate means to change, transform, metamorphosis, adjust precisely for a particular function again and it also means back to an original condition. We have also been given the principles of resetting: 1. Focusing (Get in range with God – how close are you with God). 2. Where are the most important things in your life? (Relationships: with your mate and children and with those that are concerning your destiny and assignment). Remember, what you don’t feed will fade. You need to look at and reset relationships. Also, where are things concerning your calling. 3. Give one day to one thing once a week, at least a portion and focus on that one thing. What you focus on, you will have insight in.

What is the area that you need resetting in the most? What is the area that you are most afflicted in? Ask the Holy Spirit what area that you need to reset in the most. What you look at the longest with be the strongest in your life. God has planted on the inside of everyone, the potential and power to succeed. Everything that God does in your life fits into God’s purpose. We need new information and prayer is the key. “If you reset without prayer you are doing it in your own strength.

Pastor Sheila declared that this year, we will know Him as the Greater One. Greater is He that is in us than he that is in the world. “God said in Genesis 17, He told Abraham, “I Am do

Almighty God.” When he was 99 years old, Abraham tried to some things on his own. He birthed an Ishmael and some of us have tried to do some things and birthed some different things that we are reaping now, but guess what, it’s going to all turn around because we are going to know Him as the Almighty, All-Sufficient, the God of the Impossible.

As the year has progressed God has been pressing the reset button in the lives of His people. Here are a few testimonies of how reset is happening through the body at Eagle Rock Church.

“The Holy Spirit is just taking me back to the basics in my quiet time. I have been sitting in His presence deciphering His voice. Those are just things that He has been impressing upon me. I have found that the importance of going deeper is not finding something new but just returning back to basics. In that, one of the things that He has revealed is giving and Kysha and I have been praying for opportunities in the body to grow faith through our giving. So, whether that is through a word of encouragement or whether that is financial blessing, God has already started to do that which has been amazing to watch Him do that in a different way. What’s the difference of fishing on one side of the boat or the other? There is no difference. But Jesus said cast the net to the right side, or the other side. AZUSA NOW

How in the world do I encapsulate into a few words the experience of fifteen hours of glorious prayer, praise, and presence at Azusa Now on April 9th? I’m so glad I took notes throughout the day. The first thing I wrote down when I got to the stadium was, “What a privilege to be here! Thank You, Lord, for this amazing opportunity!” And what an amazing experience it was!

One of the first things I noticed about this event was the number of young people. I would say that almost 70% of those in attendance looked like they were under 30 years of age. There were a lot of teenagers there, too. I felt encouraged that the future of the American church looks like it will be in good hands.

The event did not advertise who was going to be there, so it was clear that people came from all over the country not to see their favorite speaker or singer, but to just pray. It didn’t take long to notice that most of the people who were selected to lead prayer or worship from the platform were not introduced by name. Many of these people would be considered well-known and highly respected leaders in the body of Christ. But no one was to be there to be named or noticed. This, too, was a great encouragement.

At the very beginning of the event, dozens of Korean pastors lined the platform to pray for America. After they thanked America for sending missionaries to their country so many years ago, they prayed a prayer of impartation that the same spirit of prayer that abounds in South Korea will capture the heart of the American church drawing us to our knees to believe for a mighty move of God to manifest in our churches and in our country once again. Yes, Lord! We receive that impartation! (On July 29th, these and a multitude of other Korean pastors will line the DMZ between North Korea and South Korea to pray for a re-unification of the two countries. They have asked us to pray with them for a ‘nuclear salvation’ for North Korea. Let us agree with them in prayer).

Prayer throughout Azusa Now focused on unity within the church, healing of racial and cultural offenses (current as well as historical ones), and the need for repentance, revival, and a spiritual awakening in the church and country. The hard issues that the people of God have been guilty of participating in were laid open for everyone to hear and own up to. Everyone has been in some degree a willing participant in and/or a helpless victim of the fallen nature of man. The truth of our offenses was identified—in love, of course, and for redemptive purposes. The Holy Spirit went deep. No heart was left untouched. Prayers of forgiveness toward one another were prayed over and over again, and then the glorious balm of reconciliation was poured in to hasten the healing.

Another prayer focus throughout the day was remembering. Remembering the many wonderful things that have taken place in the church—past and present. Remembering past revivals and past moves of God. Remembering prophetic words that were spoken concerning the times we are living in now. Remembering the men and women of God of times past who have set examples for us of their love for God, their passion for reaching the lost, and their commitment for the work of the Kingdom of God.

Remembering how God has always heard the prayers of His people. And then, we would cry out, “LORD GOD—DO IT AGAIN! DO IT AGAIN!”

There was a lot of history brought out concerning the affects that the Azusa Street Revival in 1906 had on this country. One of the most notable was the fact that it broke all racial barriers in a time when racism was a far greater problem than it is now. William Seymour, a black man, was the primary leader of this move of God that removed the barriers between denominations, races, cultures, and social statuses. All sat side by side for one purpose—to experience their lives being changed in pursuit of the presence of the Lord. Only God could make that happen back then, and only God can make that happen now. LORD GOD—DO IT AGAIN! DO IT AGAIN!

William Seymour prophesied 110 years ago that in about 100 years, there will be another revival that will far eclipse the Azusa Street revival with signs and wonders and manifestations, and above all, souls. We’re due for that to happen any time. LORD GOD—DO IT AGAIN! DO IT AGAIN!

There were several covenantal moments that happened throughout the day.

- A covenantal prophetic act—stones were arranged to build a well around a cross. In biblical times, wells would be dug and then there would be a fight over who owned it, which would result in the well being blocked and useless. No longer will we allow doctrinal differences to stop up the wells that God wants to pour His Spirit of living water from.
- A covenantal prayer—We are not going to forgive one another today and then go back to criticizing and being angry with one another tomorrow. By the Spirit of the Lord God Almighty, we will walk in perpetual forgiveness and reconciliation toward one another.
- A covenantal commitment—We will honor one another and commit to pray together for revival.




There were so many other significant moments throughout the day—healings (several people walked out of wheel chairs), deliverances, salvations, baptisms of the HS. There is not enough time or paper to convey all of it. So I will conclude this by sharing a few words that were given by three fathers of the faith that were there.

- Jack Hayford—Forty years ago, God showed me that my church must pray like no one else is praying. Not that there is no one else praying because they are. But pray like no others are praying. The revival that is coming will not be sustained by celebrating it. It will be sustained by commitment to it.
- Billy Graham—(He sent word through his great grandson). Tell them to stay focused on the cross! Jesus loves you! Jesus loves you! Jesus loves you! Jesus loves you! Go into the world and tell them Jesus loves them.
- Arthur Blessit—I have carried the cross through every nation and island group on this earth. I have walked billions of steps in over 18,000 miles carrying this cross while sharing the gospel message of Christ. I have been in jail 24 times, hit by cars, and shot at. I am 75-years-old now. I am an old man. *(Then, pointing to all of those young folks in the stadium)* IT’S TIME FOR YOU TO TAKE THE CROSS...IT’S TIME FOR YOU TO TAKE THE MESSAGE OF CHRIST TO EVERY CREATURE! IT’S YOUR TURN! I COMMISSION YOU TO GO INTO EVERY NATION AND PREACH THE GOSPEL!

Lord God, we cry out for revival! We cry out for another great awakening! Do it again, Lord! Do it again!

HUMAN TRAFFICKING

Last month, the *Columbus Dispatch* reported that three people in Columbus had been arrested for human trafficking and prostitution. If convicted of the 14 counts charged, one of the accused could be sentenced for up to 50 years in prison.

According to WBNS-10TV, in Knoxville, TN, 32 people are facing charges in a human trafficking and prostitution. Among those 32 is a youth minister who is charged with human trafficking and patronizing prostitution.

“Statistics from the National Human Trafficking Resource Center in Washington, DC show human trafficking cases in Ohio are some of the highest in the nation. A FOX19 NOW analysis of NHTRC statistics shows Ohio reported 289 human trafficking cases in 2015.

That is the fourth-highest tally in the nation, behind only California, Texas and Florida.

Since the NHTRC started compiling statistics in 2007, Ohio’s ranked fifth in the nation among states with reported cases at 833.

Ohio also ranks fifth in the nation in the number of human trafficking-related calls to help lines with 3,693 calls in the last decade.” Jody Barr, Investigative Reporter, Fox 19 Now online.
